That the Police Jury authorize the Resolution approving the holding of an election for Fire Protection District No. 2, of the Parish of Acadia, State of Louisiana, on Saturday, November 18, 2017, to authorize the levy of a special tax for the purpose of constructing, acquiring, improving, maintaining and operating facilities and equipment.
11. Adopt an ordinance setting a 35 MPH Speed Limit on Heinen Road.
12. Authorize the President to execute a Cooperative Agreement between Acadia Parish Police Jury and the Louisiana Department of Veterans Affairs.
13. Authorize the President to sign an application for Federal Assistance for the Louisiana Housing Corporation Emergency Solutions Grant Program.
14. That the Police Jury accept the Airport Improvement Program Grant for the Terminal Apron Pavement Rehabilitation and authorize the president to sign all Federal and State grant agreements required for this project.
15. Authorize the President to execute a contract with the State of Louisiana Office of Community Development for FY 2015-2016 Community Water Enrichment Funds in the amount of \$42,000.00 for major improvements to the Mire-Branch Water Corporation Public Water Distribution Plant System.
16. Approve Contract Change Order No. 1, Authorize Notice of Termination, and adopt the Resolution of Termination for the Excavation of Phase IV Project at the Acadia Parish Sanitary Landfill.
17. Budget adjustments to Rice Arena for legal services.

18. Accept recommendation of the Finance Committee. (Mr. Guidry)

- a. That the Police Jury authorize OneAcadia for the filing of a grant application in partnership with the Acadia Arts Council for the Delta Regional Authority's Creative Placemaking Initiative Grant program.

19. Accept recommendations of the Road and Bridge Committee. (Mr. Guidry)

- a. Authorize the President to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Crowley for a design-build project to repair and reopen the bridge over the Crowley Center Ditch on West Northern Avenue, estimated to cost \$138,500, committing the Police Jury to funding in the amount of \$50,000 plus administrative cost; and authorize the President to obtain proposals from interested contractors for a pre-engineered piling repair project, all contingent upon Capital Manufacturing providing funding in the amount of \$50,000, and the City of Crowley providing funding in the amount of \$38,500.
- b. Authorize Mr. Brad Andrus, Parish Legal Counsel, to provide legal opinion on Right to Forest Act in regards to Surety Bond Road Permit requirements.
- c. That the Police Jury authorize a public hearing to set a 15mph speed limit on Fiddle Road.

20. Accept recommendation of the Solid Waste Committee (Mr. Faul)

- a. That the Police Jury authorize and direct the President to engage Right of Way Services, Inc. to provide the necessary real estate appraisal, for the purpose of purchasing property to secure soil material to help meet the operational demands for cover material In the future.

21. Presentation of monthly financial report by Delegated Secretary-Treasurer.
